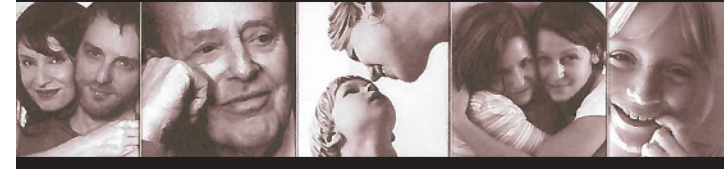

TEXAS PANHANDLE CENTERS

Texas Panhandle Centers (TPC) is a locally controlled non-profit organization that serves adults and youth with severe mental illness, intellectual and developmental disabilities, and children from birth to three years of age who experience developmental delays.

TPC was formed when two organizations that both began providing services in 1966 (Texas Panhandle Mental Health Authority and the Amarillo State Center) combined in 2000. At the heart of TPC's work is our mission:

Mission: To respond to the behavioral and developmental health needs of individuals by creating an accessible system of care that supports individual choice and results in lives of dignity and independence.

VISION

Our mission, in turn, serves as the cornerstone to fulfill our vision of **Making Lives Better**. Texas Panhandle Centers provides services and supports with the shared goal of improving the quality of life for each person we serve.



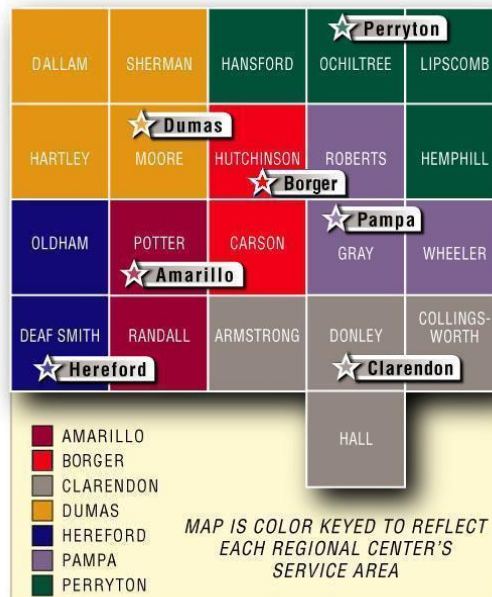
