Texas Panhandle Centers Behavioral and Developmental Health is part of the Texas Community Center system and is governed by a local Board of Trustees representing the citizens of the upper twenty-one Texas Panhandle counties. The primary populations that we serve are adults and youth with severe mental illness, intellectual and developmental disabilities, and children birth to three years of age experiencing developmental delays.

Clients and staff decide, together, on individual plans of care that can include a wide service array such as assessment, service coordination, medication and a variety of other treatment and therapeutic supports. At the heart of TPC's work is our mission.

INTELLECTUAL AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES...

...Is usually a permanent condition that begins sometime between birth and the age of eighteen (18). Person with intellectual and developmental disabilities experience intellectual functioning significantly below average (an IQ below 70) and skills and behaviors that do not meet the level of independence expected of the person's age and culture.

AVAILABLE SERVICES

Services usually begin with screening and diagnosis. Upon establishment of eligibility, the individual is provided with services to meet their needs. Services include:

Texas Panhandle Centers strives to meet the needs of its clients through community-based programs as an alternative to treatment in a state institution. Texas Panhandle Centers serves Panhandle families and clients in their own community, including workshops for adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities located in six Panhandle cities.
