WHAT IS MENTAL HEALTH DOCKET?

The Mental Health Docket was created to identify individuals in the local jails with multiple incarcerations who would benefit from mental health services in the community.

The Mental Health Docket is a six-month intensive program which includes case management, physician and medication services. Other services are dependent on the individual's needs but may include counseling, peer support and substance abuse treatment programs.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Individuals with a serious mental illness
- Individual's serious mental illness is causing them serious life problems
- 1 or more prior arrests in the past year
- Individual agrees to participate
- Magistrate agrees to take the case
- Individual is an adult with no guardian
- Individuals in Potter and Randall County Detention Centers

EXCLUSION CRITERIA

- Pending felony charges



COORDINATION OF SERVICE

The Mental Health Docket Team completes the initial assessment. The client is then linked with the appropriate community resources and provided intensive case management. A variety of resources are available and may include, but are not limited to:

- Psychiatric Evaluation for medication therapy
- Outreach, Screening, Assessment & Referral Services (OSAR)
- Peer Support
- Respite and Recovery
- Counseling through Family Support Services
- Inpatient Drug Treatment

Mission: To respond to the behavioral and developmental health needs of individuals by creating an accessible system of care that supports individual choice and results in lives of dignity and independence.

PROGRAM OBJECTIVE

To address the underlying cause of recidivism in the lives of participants and advocate for their release from jail so that they may engage in a recovery process.
