Clients and staff decide, together, on personal plans of care that can include a wide range of services such as assessment, case management, counseling, medication and a broad variety of other treatment and therapeutic supports. At the heart of TPC's work is our mission.

To respond to the behavioral and developmental health needs of individuals by creating an accessible system of care that supports individual choice and results in lives of dignity and independence.

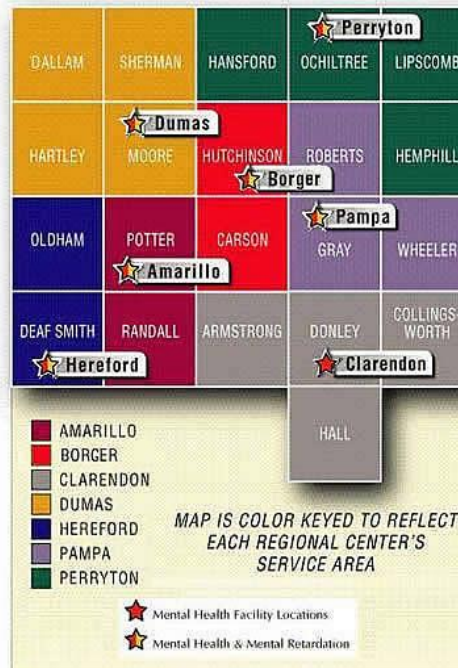
VISION
